Céiliúradh 1916-2016

Mar chuid de na hócáidí atá éagraithe ag an rialtas le comóradh 1916 bronnfar Brat na hÉireann ar gach scoil sa tír. Ansin ar an 16/03/16 ardófar na scoileanna ar fad na bratacha le chéile in ómós don ócáid. Beidh Gaelscoil na Mí ag fáil cuairt ón airm ar an 20/01/16 chun cóip den forógra agus Brat na hÉireann a fháil.

As part of the 1916 government centenary celebrations every school in the country will be presented with the national flag. On the 16/03/16 all the schools in the country will raise their flag for the first time to mark the occasion. Gaelscoil na Mí will be presented with the flag and a copy of the proclamation by two representatives of the defence forces on the 20/01/06.

Each school ceremony will only last 30 minutes & we have organised a very simple presentation for the occasion. Due to space restrictions we are only able to invite members of the PA committee and members of the Board of Management.
