I don't speak Irish. How will I be able to help with homework?

96% of parents in our school have little or no Irish. The teachers understand this and homework is given with this in mind. Your child will be fluent in both Irish and English and will be able to ask you questions in either language.

Who can attend?

Our school is inclusive and open to everyone regardless of faith, ethnic background, language of the home or special educational needs. This is reflected in our enrolment policy. We would love to use our experience and expertise to give your child an excellent education.

What extra-curricular activities are available?

As a school, we actively encourage our students to pursue their talents outside of school hours. We currently have many talented musicians, artists and sports players attending our school. We also accomodate a number of extra-curricular activities in the school and plan on growing the choices available going forward.

Is this school suitable for children with special needs?

Yes. We cater for students with Special Educational Needs in both our Autism Class and mainstream classes. We provide the same supports available as other schools. All evidence shows that pupils with special needs do just as well in an Irish-medium setting as they do in the Englishmedium system. Total early immersion is recognised as the most successful model for children with special needs.

In Gaelscoil na Mí we believe in putting the happiness of our students first. That means passionate teachers providing a holistic education, a school that's welcoming of everyone and providing extra opportunities for our students - and we do all this with Irish culture as the common denominator.
